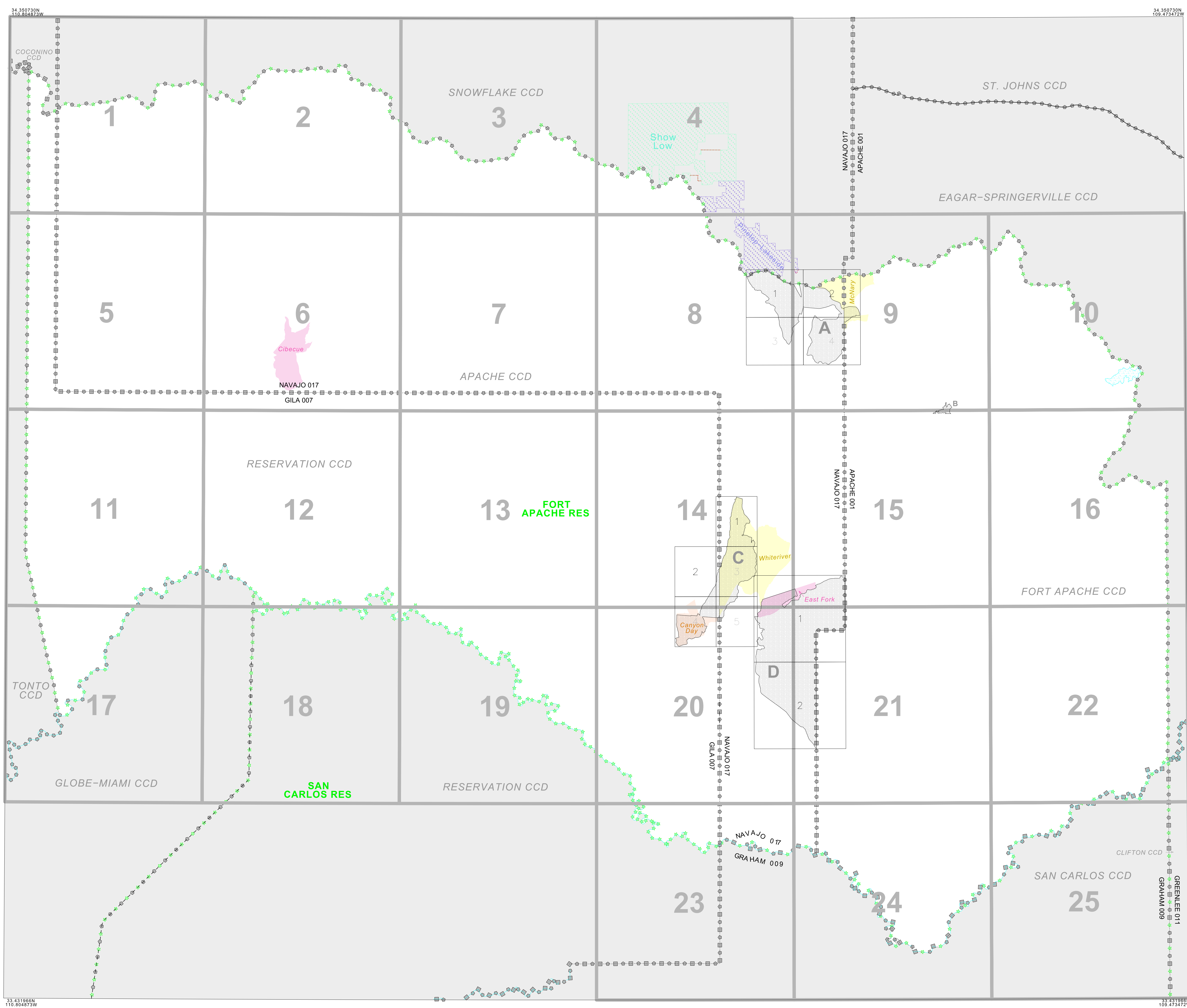

² This map shows tribal census tract boundaries and numbers within the subject entity; nontribal census tract boundaries are shown outside of the subject entity but without numbers. A tribal census tract is a type of census tract defined within a federally recognized American Indian reservation or off-reservation trust land for the purpose of providing data based on an American Indian hierarchy rather than by state and county. Where reservations or off-reservation trust lands cross state or county boundaries, the same tribal census tract number may be assigned to both sides of the boundary and, if so, constitutes a single tribal census tract entity.

³ A " " following a block number indicates that the block number is repeated elsewhere in the block.
