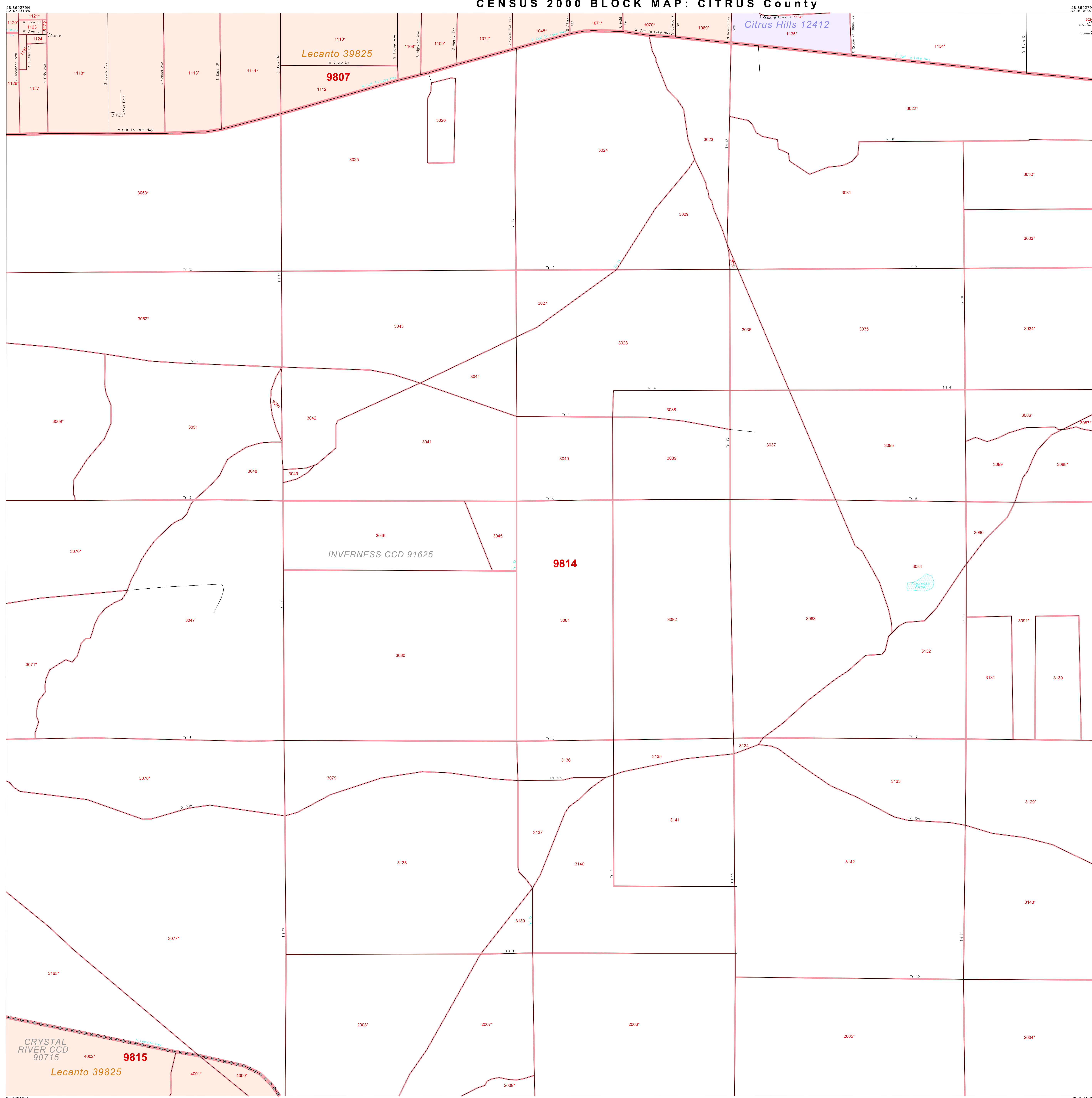


CENSUS 2000 BLOCK MAP: CITRUS County
